- One-page statement detailing your qualifications for serving as an AI, your academic goals, and your progress toward your current degree
- **Two** letters of evaluation from faculty addressing your potential for academic work and for teaching
- Evidence of the quality of your teaching if you have previously taught in EALC or elsewhere (e.g., student evaluations, video, etc.)
