

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Am I eligible to apply if I have never studied Mandarin Chinese before? Yes! You will just need to provide a recommendation letter from an IU instructor in your application.
- 2. Are graduate students eligible to apply to this program? Yes, all IU students are eligible.
- 3. There are two Chinese language programs at NTU; which one should I choose? We encourage students to explore ICLP and CLD's respective websites and decide which program is better suited for their learning goals.
- 4. Should I apply directly to the language programs? No, once students apply to the NTU Taiwan Huayu BEST Program through EALC, they do not need to submit a separate application to CLD or ICLP.
- 5. Would housing be provided through the program? No, housing is not included as part of the program. The NTU staff will share and recommend housing options around Taipei, but students are responsible for securing their housing.
- 6. When are the deadlines for application? Deadlines will be updated periodically on the EALC website for the Huayu BEST Program. Please check the website for the most current deadline for each quarter term.
- 7. Will my grades at NTU be factored into my IU GPA? Yes.
- 8. What are the scholarship amounts I will be receiving? NTU will be providing a monthly scholarship of NT \$25,000 (approx. USD \$830 pending exchange rate) during students' duration of studies. IU will provide a one-time scholarship for each student; actual scholarship amounts will depend on the number of program participants.
- 9. Are there other short-term programs at NTU for Chinese language studies? Yes, the <u>NTU Plus Academy</u> offers a six-week program that combines Chinese language courses with cultural excursions, providing an immersive learning experience for international students.
